Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 307, 452, 447, 427, 148, 149 of IPC and 25/27/25 (54)/59 of Arms Act in a case arising out of FIR No.60 dated 07.06.2009, registered at Police Station Sarhali District Tarn Taran.

Petitioner was granted bail by the trial Court and he could not appear before the trial Court on 15.05.2013. Therefore, his bail bonds and surety bonds were ordered to be cancelled and he was declared proclaimed offender. Thereafter, he surrendered before the trial Court by moving an application for surrender and bail in Court, which was dismissed on 17.12.2014. The petitioner was present on the spot along with some unidentified persons near the house of the complainant where Rajwinder Singh fired from his gun on the father of the complainant. No other role has been attributed to the preent

petitioner.

Keeping in view the above facts, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.
