The prayer in the petition is that respondents No. 1 to 4 may be directed to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No. 3 dated 02.01.2015 of Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana.

It is not understandable as to how such direction can be given to the police because even if it is directed that fair investigation be conducted, it will be meaningless. No such direction can be sought in the first place.

The direction to arrest the remaining accused can also not be given because it will have to be seen during investigation whether they are found prima facie guilty or innocent.

Dismissed.
