Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking direction for handing over the investigation of FIR No.40 dated 24.4.2015 registered under Sections 302 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' for short) at Police Station, Makbul Pura, District Amritsar, to some independent agency like Central Bureau of Investigation for fair, impartial and effective investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when the grievance of the petitioner was not being redressed, he finally approached respondent No.3, by way of self-contained representation dated 30.4.2015 (Annexure P-3), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that at this stage, petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to consider his representation and take an appropriate action thereon, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar-respondent No.3, is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner raised in representation dated 30.4.2015 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of four weeks from today from the date of receipt of a

certified copy of this order. Respondent No.3 is also directed to ensure fair, impartial and effective as well as early investigation of the above-said FIR No.40 dated 24.4.2015 registered under Sections 302 and 34 IPC at Police Station, Makbul Pura, District Amritsar

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
