This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No.48 dated 03.05.2014 under Sections 323/324/148/149/354 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Division No.7, District Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

Report from the trial Court has been received in which it is mentioned that parties including all the injured, have arrived at a compromise.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also stated at the bar that the matter has been compromised. It was a personal dispute which has been amicably settled between the parties.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, "**Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others**" **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the above said FIR stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also stands quashed.
