This petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass and humiliate the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.4 and not to call the petitioners into police station frequently except initiating the process under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Mr. Kamal Narula, Advocate has put in appearance and filed power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.5, same is taken on record.

Reply by way of affidavit of Baljeet Singh, DSP, Sub-Division Fazilka, District Fazilka on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed, which is taken on record. It has been categorically mentioned in Para No.3 of the reply/status report that at present no complaint/application is pending against petitioners and they are no more required by the police. However, in case any complaint is received against the petitioners in future, the police will call the petitioners by following the legal procedure.

In view of the reply furnished by the State, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and disposed of, as such.
