Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in complaint No.31 dated 03.10.2012, under Sections 436, 427, 451, 395, 353, 186, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 titled as Jeeta Singh versus Jagtar Singh and others”.

While issuing, notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 06.07.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner in the State case arising out of this very occurrence. Co-accused Jaspal Singh @ Pal has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court in this very complaint case.

Notice of motion for 19.08.2015.

In the meanwhile, if the petitioner appears before the trial Court/ Committing Court, he shall be admitted to the interim bail on furnishing the requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Court concerned”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the above order, petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court on 10.07.2015 and has furnished the necessary bail bonds.

Accordingly, the interim bail furnished by the petitioner before the trial Court in pursuance to the order dated 06.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
