Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 17 dated 05.02.2015 under Sections 392 and 397 IPC and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal.

2. Undisputably, petitioner was arrested in this case on March 23, 2015 and was subjected to custodial interrogation. During which, a sum of ₹500/- is alleged to have been recovered from his possession.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ved Parkash submits that there is no other case either pending or disposed of against the petitioner. No recovery of any fire arm or any type of weapon has been effected from his possession. Report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C has already been presented in the Court of learned Jurisdictional Magistrate, which is fixed for arguments and charge. Certainly disposal of challan would take sufficient long time.

4. In the given circumstances, this Court is of considered view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars for indefinite period.

5. Accordingly, instant petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail at the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
