Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.36 dated 19.04.2015, under Sections 379 of IPC and 21(1) of Mines and Minerals Act, 1957, registered at Police Station Ramdass, District Amritsar.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 06.05.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioners would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

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On instructions from HC Kuldip Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioners have joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioners and their custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 06.05.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
