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Prayer made in the petition is for cancellation of bail of respondents No.2 to 8 granted by this Court vide different orders, copies of which have been placed on record as Annexure P-2 (Collectively).

The main ground taken by the petitioner, who is the complainant in the case, for seeking cancellation of the bail of respondents No.2 to 8 is that the trial was being delayed and the complainant being threatened by the accused persons to withdraw all the cases pending against them.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 to 8 has informed the Court that subsequent to framing of the charges by the trial Court, the prosecution has examined its entire evidence. Even the accused have been examined under Section 313 Cr.P.C. and now the case is fixed for recording of the defence witnesses for 10.07.2015.

In view of the stand taken by learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 8, which has not been disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner, no case is made out for cancellation of bail of the private respondents.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
