Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.185 dated 3.12.2014 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.5, District Jalandhar.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 7.8.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner has deposited an amount of Rs.50,000/- with the investigating officer, who has paid the same to the complainant. He further submits that petitioner has not misused the concession of interim anticipatory bail, granted by this Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Surinderpal Singh, Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar, submits that in compliance of the order dated 7.8.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 7.8.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
