This petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.80 dated 28.04.2015 registered at Police Station Kambo, District Amritsar for offences punishable under Sections 457, 380 and 411 of IPC.

Heard.

Learned State Counsel submits that after the registration of the FIR on the basis of secret information, Harjinder Singh @ Kala son of Gopal Singh r/o Bal Kalan, Sabu son of Prem Singh, Ravi son of Rulda Singh and Manga son of Swaran Singh were apprehended on the allegation that they have committed theft of wheat from the godown of Punjab Agro village Bal Kalan. On the basis of disclosure statement of the aforesaid persons, a raid was conducted and 10 bags of wheat of Punjab Agro were recovered from the house of the applicant-petitioner. The submission made by learned State Counsel disclose an offence under Section 411 against the petitioner. The recovery has already been effected.

Keeping in view the above facts, but without commenting anything on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join the investigation. In the event of his arrest being required he will be allowed bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of arresting officer till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
