This is an application for anticipatory bail in case bearing

FIR No. 21 dated 11.04.2015, registered under Section 420,120 B IPC at

Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, Gurdaspur.

On 27.08.2015 the following order was passed:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is trying to settle the matter and seeks a short adjournment.

Adjourned to 05.11.2015.

Interim order to continue."

Thereafter on 05.11.2015 the matter was again adjourned

at the request of learned counsel for the petitioner. Today learned

counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is not in a position

to make any payment. He has, however, argued that the petitioner has

been falsely implicated. Learned Addl.AG points out that once the

petitioner has represented to this Court that he is wanting to settle the matter his volte-face dis-entitles him from the discretionary relief of bail.

I find this to be a fair submission.

Consequently the present petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
