AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 07 dated 11.01.2014, under Sections 21/22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kurali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody for the last one year. Learned Addl.AG states that out of 12 witnesses, 5 have been examined and 7 official witnesses remain to be examined and the prosecution undertakes to conclude its evidence by 31.03.2015 (subject to the fact that the petitioner does not obstruct the

same).

In these circumstances this petition is dismissed at this stage but it is directed that in case the prosecution evidence is not concluded by 31.03.2015(subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same)the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
