Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondents No.4 and 5.

As per the report of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, the petitioners have appeared before the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samrala and have given affidavits that they are living happily and do not want any protection. This could be one of the the reasons why none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

Consequently the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage.
