The transfer of the case bearing FIR No.04 dated 23.05.2014 registered at Police Station Gurdaspur for offence punishable under Section 420 and 406 IPC, pending trial in the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur, has been sought on the ground that the parents of the petitioner are old and suffering from ailments. There is no other member in the family to look after them in his absence. It is also averred that whenever the petitioner goes to Gurdaspur, to attend proceedings arising out of the above FIR, the complainant party makes false report to the police, which on enquiry had been filed.

On perusal of the petition and hearing the submissions of counsel for the petitioner, I find no reason for transfer of the case from Gurdaspur to Mohali or Chandigarh. This petition has no merit.

Dismissed.
