The application is allowed and affidavit of Sanjiv Singla brother of the petitioner is taken on record.

CRM No.M-18562 OF 2015

This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.308 dated 27.12.2013 registered at Police Station City Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur for offences punishable under Section 406 and 420 IPC.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the value of rice sheller and his landed property is more than 3,00,00,000/- and the same are already under the attachment. The petitioner and his brother who are the owners of that property have no objection if that property is put to

auction to recover the award amount. He has also placed on record an affidavit by Sanjiv Singla to this effect.

The petitioner was arrested in this case on 09.04.2015. The Challan in this case has been filed and the trial is going on.

It is submitted that there is already award of ₹3,36,04,679/- in which the proceedings are going on.

In view of the undertaking given by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is allowed. Petitioner-Pardeep Kumar Singla is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur, subject to following terms:-

1. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
2. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh before the trial Court.
3. He shall not leave the country without previous permission of the Court.
