The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.264 dated 23.12.2014 under Sections 498-A/406/420/506/120-B IPC, P.S. City, Kotakpura, District Faridkot.

On 20.02.2015 this Court passed the following order:-

“Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Balraj Singh (father-in-law) and Harbaksh Kaur (mother-in-law), who have been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 498-A and 506, IPC, in a case arising out of FIR

No.264, dated 23.12.2014, registered at Police Station, City, Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Notice of motion for 09.04.2015.

In the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to ad-interim bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

The petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

In compliance of the aforesaid order, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and undertakes to join further investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Surinderjit Singh also admitted the above said fact.

In view of the above, order dated 20.02.2015 is made absolute.

Petitions stands disposed of.
