Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. on behalf of two petitioners/accused, namely, Sukhwinder Singh Sandhu and Reya @ Ravinder Kaur is for quashing of FIR No.811 dated 11.12.2014, under Sections 420, 406, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar (**Annexure P-1**) and the subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 13.04.2015 and affidavit dated 13.04.2015 of the complainant/respondent No.2-Rani Dhiman (**Annexures P-2 and 3** respectively) arrived at between the parties.

As per the allegations, complainant/respondent No.2-Rani Dhiman had paid a sum of Rs.7 Lacs (approximately) to both the petitioners/accused for sending her sons Rahul and Yadvender abroad. Since the sons were not sent abroad, the aforesaid amount was sought to be

returned by the present petitioners/accused by way of two cheques, which on presentation were dishonoured.

Learned Counsel for respondent No.2/complainant submits that his client has not settled any dispute regarding the present FIR with the petitioners/accused.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Kumar, submits that the matter is still under investigation.

In view of the stand of the complainant that there is no compromise between the parties, no further orders are required to be passed.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
