SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.171 dated 05.05.2015, under Section 15 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 ('Act' for short), registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 29.05.2015:-

“Contends that the petitioner was not arrested from the spot and his name has figured in the disclosure statement of co-accused.

Notice of motion for 24.8.2015.

In the meantime, the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed subject to the following conditions :-

i) He will make himself available for investigation as and when required to do so.

ii) He will not leave the country without the prior

permission of the Court.

iii) He will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police official.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sub Inspector Pawan Kumar has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation. On a query put by this Court, learned State counsel has further submitted that no other case is pending against the petitioner under the Act.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 29.05.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
