The petitioners are working as Kacha Arhtias in the Assandh Grain Market. In the present writ petition, they are seeking quashing of the eligibility criteria fixed by the Administrator, Market Committee, Assndh as well as Rule 3(1)(iii) of the Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board (Sale of Immovable Property) Rules, 2000.

Undisputedly, before coming to this Court, the petitioners never applied to the respondents for allotment of the plots and at no point of time their claim was ever rejected by a speaking order. Learned counsel for the petitioners further informs that some of the petitioners have been allotted the plots/shops subsequently.

In light of these facts, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to approach the respondents for allotment of the plots/shops and in

case their claim is rejected with a further liberty that they can challenge the said order, in accordance with law.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty and in case the claim of the petitioners is not acceded to, it will be open for them to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
