The Petitioner has filed this petition seeking the relief of protection of life and liberty on the basis of alleged threat being extended on behalf of respondent nos.5 to 8. Besides, a fair and proper inquiry is also sought on the complaint given by the petitioner against the private respondent nos.5 to 8.

The official respondent nos.1 to 4 have filed a short reply by way of an affidavit through DSP (Headquarter) Hisar, wherein it is pointed out that the petitioner and respondent no.5 were engaged in sale and purchase of property and a dispute had arisen between them. Both the parties have given complaint against each other wherein preventive measure proceedings under Section 107/150 Cr.PC were carried out. The property in

question which is the subject matter of dispute is also subject matter of proceedings under Section 145 Cr.PC.

Counsel for the parties heard at length.

The petitioner has made an attempt to seek protection without establishing any genuine threat as alleged in the petition as the parties are already before the competent authorities. The petitioner is already stated to be involved in number of criminal cases as mentioned in the affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, therefore, there does not exist any alleged threat warranting interference under Section 482 Cr.PC.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
