The petitioners had earlier approached the District and Sessions Judge, Mansa for protection of their life and liberty which was allowed vide order dated 26.05.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that parties would be residing at Sangrur and by mistake the petition was filed before the District and Sessions Judge, Mansa.

Sarabjeet Kaur and Jaswinder Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 8 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No. 4 to 8. They have placed on record marriage certificate and photographs, Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 27.05.2015, Annexure P-6 to respondent No. 2.

Without commenting upon the legality of the marriage and entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the

documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-6 within a period of one month and grant the protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
