Reply dated 28.09.2015 filed on behalf of respondent No.8 in the Court today, is taken on record and copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, while referring to the inquiry reports at Annexures R-1 and R-2 annexed with the reply filed by way of affidavit dated 13.07.2015 on behalf of respondents No.1, 2 & 4, submits that matter was enquired into and no threat perception, as raised by the petitioner, was found existing. Learned counsel for the State further submits that if the petitioner faces any threat to her life and liberty at the hands of respondents even in future, she would be at liberty to move the appropriate

representation and the same shall be looked into immediately, by taking an appropriate action thereon.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that let the present petition be disposed of, in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to approach the competent authority, as and when necessity arises.

In view of the abovesaid statements made by learned counsel for the parties, instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali-respondent No.2 that as and when the petitioner approaches him, by moving an approach representation raising threat perception, he shall consider the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner, at the hands of respondents or by anybody else on behalf of the respondents.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
