Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.324 dated 28.12.2013, under Sections 294, 382, 354, 148, 149, 506 and 342 IPC registered at Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar on the basis of compromise. The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2-complainant Paramjot Kaur alleging that the petitioners along with 50-60 persons entered in the office of the complainant and assaulted her on account of pendency of litigation between the landlord and the tenant.

Parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded. A report has been received that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal)**

1052, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that petitioners will deposit a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority within a period of one month.
