Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks direction to the respondent authorities to conduct fair and effective investigation in FIR No.199 dated 25.11.2011 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Cantonment, Tehsil and District Amritsar.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto reply has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Malook Singh, Police Station Cantonment, Tehsil and District Amritsar, submits that effective investigating is being carried out. However, petitioner has not cooperated with the investigating agency.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is very much ready to join and cooperate with the investigating agency in carrying out effective investigation.

In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar-respondent No.2 to ensure effective and early investigation in the matter. Petitioner is also directed to join the investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency. Petitioner is also granted liberty to pursue his other remedies, in accordance with law after conclusion of investigation by the investigating agency.

With the above-said made observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
