DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their lives and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are apprehending threat at the instance of private respondents as they have solemnized marriage contrary to the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7.

In response to notice of motion, reply has been filed by the State but none has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 to 7.

As per reply filed by the State, respondents No.4 to 7 have stated in their statements that they do not want to maintain relation with petitioner No.1 and there is no danger from any corner to the life and liberty of both the petitioners at their behest.

Since, there is no danger to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the instance of private respondents, which has been mentioned in the written statement filed on behalf of the State, the instant petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as such.

However, in case, the petitioners are still apprehending threat at the instance of private respondents, they are at liberty to move representation to the concerned police authorities and the police authorities are directed to consider the representation, if any, and pass necessary order in accordance with law.
