It is submitted that the name of the village of respondent No. 4 -Balwant Singh has been wrongly mentioned as Karamgarh instead of village Chhapa. Since it is an obvious mistake, then name of village is allowed to be corrected here. Correction has been made by the counsel for the petitioners.

Heard. Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab. State counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

Petitioners, Kuldeep Kaur and Harpreet Singh, have moved this Court seeking protection on the ground that they have married on 22.05.2015 against the wishes of their parents and relatives.

Counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners had

moved a representation (Annexure P-5) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, to seek protection, but no action has been taken by the police.

In this view of the matter, Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) and if there is any substance in it, may proceed further, in accordance with law.

The present order, however, shall not be deemed to be proof qua the factum/validity of any matrimonial alliance of the petitioners.
