Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks direction against the respondents to ensure meticulous compliance of the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. by issuing appropriate notice to the petitioner in case he is required in any case.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the State submits that earlier intimation was sent to the petitioner which was received by mother of the petitioner and she stated that petitioner was out of station. However, petitioner never came present before the police authorities. She further submits that in fact the intimation was sent to the petitioner under some suspicion but after conducting an enquiry, petitioner has not been found involved in any criminal case. She would next contend that since the petitioner is not required in any criminal case, no further notice will be sent to him. She also submits that if the petitioner would be required in any criminal case, meticulous compliance of the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. shall be ensured.

In view of the above-said statement made by the learned counsel for the State, no further orders are called for.

Disposed of, accordingly.
