1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment ?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not ?

RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)

On 03.06.2015, this Court passed the following order:-

“Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail on the ground that he was found innocent on the basis of inquiry conducted by DIG, State Cyber Crime, Punjab and now he has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

In the FIR the allegations are that the petitioner along with Maninder Singh Chahal @ Kukkar caught hold of Arsh Jangra and Satwant Singh

@ Satti inflicted knife blow on left side of his chest on heart.

With the able assistance of both the learned counsel for the parties, I have perused the images of CCTV footages. Petitioner and Satwant Singh @ Satti are real brothers. In CCTV footages Maninder Singh Chahal @ Kukkar, Satwant Singh @ Satti and Gurpreet Singh @ Dara are seen.

The first CCTV footage at about 8.15.36 p.m. shows Satwant Singh @ Satti and Gurpreet Singh @ Dara going towards Point X as per site plan (Annexure P-4). In second footage Maninder Singh Chahal @ Kukkar was seen running towards Point Y. In third CCTV footage Arsh Jangra and Satwant Singh @ Satti were seen running towards Point Y. In fourth CCTV footage Arsh Jangra was being taken back by his brother along with two more person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is not shown in any footage and he was also found innocent in inquiry conducted by senior police officer.

At this stage, without commenting upon merits of this case as well as on validity of CCTV footages, let notice of motion be issued to respondent-State of Punjab for 07.07.2015.

Till then arrest of petitioner is stayed.”

Petitioner was found innocent during the course of investigation. He has been summoned with the aid of Section 319 Cr.P.C. 08.07.2015 is the date fixed before the trial Court. Petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court. In the event

of his appearance, trial Court shall grant him bail, subject to its satisfaction. Petitioner shall appear on each and every date thereafter.

Disposed of.

Nothing expressed hereinabove, would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case including the CCTV footages.
