Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.04 dated 01.01.2015 registered under Section 420, 365, 406, 365, 342, 506, 120-B IPC, Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar (Rural).

The FIR came to be registered at the instance of Gurdeep Singh. Allegations are that cheating and forgery have been made in the context of sending people abroad and also indulging in grabbing of passport and abusing the complainant. Complainant was also made to suffer at gun point and was lodged in an isolated place by tying hands and legs.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ramail Singh states that police has not collected any incriminating material by visiting Baldogra, where the complainant was put into confinement and harassed. Challan

has been presented on 16.03.2015 and even charges have been framed on 09.07.2015. Petitioner is in custody since 15.01.2015 according to police record.

In view of aforesaid, without commenting upon the merits of this case, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
