Prayer in the application is for grant of bail pending trial. The petitioner has been arrayed as an accused in FIR No. 53 dated 7.5.2015, under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanpur, District Kapurthala.

It is submitted that the petitioner is about 80 years of age. There are no direct allegations against her, as the allegation of abduction is against Balwant Singh @ Boota, son of the petitioner. The only allegation against the petitioner in the FIR is that Balwant Singh had connived with her in abduction of the grand-daughter of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the State did not dispute the fact that the only allegation against the petitioner is of connivance and further she is about 80 years of age.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the submissions noticed above, in my opinion, the petitioner deserves to be granted concession of bail pending trial. She is directed to be released on bail pending trial on furnishing of bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Kapurthala.

The petition stands disposed of.
