Learned State counsel by relying upon para No.3 of the preliminary submissions of reply filed by Gurnam Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (North) Amritsar City contends that at the instance of petitioner independent and impartial investigation was conducted by Police. ADCP Amritsar City-II has recommended the case that no further investigation is required as untraced report is pending consideration before Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City. As soon as the approval is given, untraced report will be presented to Court.

In view of aforesaid, in the event of acceptance of untraced report by the Court, this petition would become infructuous, however liberty be given to the petitioner that in case untraced report is not accepted by the Court, then he may move this Court by way of fresh petition on same cause of action.

Disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
