Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 66, dated 20.05.2015 under Section 13A-3-67 of the Punjab Gambling Act read with Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station, Division No. 2, Pathankot.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 03.06.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from HC Vimal Kumar, learned State

counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 03.06.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
