This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.6 dated 17.02.2015 under Sections 307/326/324/323/148/149 and 120-B IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Malout (City) Muktsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no serious injury is attributed to the petitioner. He is in custody since May 22, 2015. besides, he has to undergo an advanced surgery.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that allegations are serious.

However, keeping in view the medical condition of the petitioner, the fact that injury attracting offence under Section 307 IPC is not attributed to him and period of his incarceration, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.
