Petitioner prays for appropriate directions to be issued to the official respondents so that he can run his business uninterruptedly without any hindrance.

On due consideration of the matter, I am of the opinion that the instant petition is totally mis-conceived. The petitioner alleges that he has a licence to run a liquor business which is being obstructed by certain persons. The petitioner has failed to substantiate any genuine grievance. He has not named the persons who are threatening him or are obstructing his business.

The respondents have verified the grievance and found it to be false.

Hence, instant petition is dismissed with costs of Rs.10,000/- which shall be recovered from the petitioner and deposited before the Haryana State Legal Service Authority.
