It is submitted that the petitioners are the parents-in-law of complainant Rubby and her husband Ankit Garg was earlier arrested and is now on bail.

In the report dated 24.03.2015, made by one Assistant Sub-Inspector from Police Station Model Town, Panipat, whose name from the signatures appears to be Birender Singh, it is mentioned that the accused persons were not cooperating in the investigation.

The Court below also observed that the present petitioners had not joined investigation despite being served with notice under Section 160 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as is mentioned in the report.

The Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat, rightly declined the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Any person who does not join the investigation as and when called upon to do so is not entitled to any such relief.

Dismissed.
