Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 66, dated 07.05.2014, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Doraha, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 10.06.2015, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from ASI Kewal Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 10.06.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
