Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.188 dated 08.04.2015 under Sections 406, 498-A, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sarai Khawaja, District Faridabad.

While recording the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court vide order dated 3.6.2015 had released the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to compliance of provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

On 10.7.2015, learned counsel for the State had pointed out that

despite there being a categorical order directing the petitioner to join the investigation, the petitioner had not joined the same. Accordingly, vide order dated 10.7.2015, this Court had directed the petitioner to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to that order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Asman Singh, states that as directed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and order dated 03.06.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when directed by the investigating officer and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
