By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.29, dated 29.04.1997, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Section 13(1) r/w Section 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Jalandhar.

The representative from the Department states that the case of the petitioner being covered under OTS Policy, 2015 initiated by the State of Punjab has been approved by the competent authority and is pending consideration with the Board of Directors of the

Corporation.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has instructions to make statement that whatever will the calculation furnished by the Bank, the petitioner shall abide by the same and make the payment within four weeks on receipt of such communication with complete calculation.

Heard.

In this view of the matter, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
