SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.282 dated 07.05.2015, under Sections 306/ 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 03.06.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners states that deceased Madan Lal took land of one Rajbir on lease and he could not make the payment to lessor. Resultantly, he borrowed money from Satpal son of Chattar, Bijender son of Arjun and Amar son of Joga. He defaulted in repaying the amount to aforesaid persons, despite their repeated demands. On that account, allegations are that he remained sad and ultimately committed suicide by hanging in a kotha

situated in the fields. Learned counsel states that there is no concerted efforts on the part of petitioners to abet commission of alleged crime, nor the ingredients of offence under Section 306 IPC are attracted. Borrowing by the deceased stands admitted in the FIR.

Notice of motion for 17.08.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Sub Inspector Ram Dhari has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 03.06.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
