This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Division No.8, District Ludhiana City, vide FIR No.23 dated 18.3.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is nothing in the FIR to substantiate the allegations levelled by the complainant. Thus, petitioner deserves to be granted concession of pre-arrest bail.

Prayer has been opposed by the State counsel. According to him, petitioner is involved in six other cases of similar nature. She after taking money from the innocent persons, shifts her office.

It appears that petitioner has been duping innocent citizens of their money on the promise of sending them abroad. She is not entitled to discretionary relief of anticipatory bail.
