This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No.63 dated 2.9.2014 under Sections 323/498-A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Respondent – Surinder Kaur is present, who has filed an affidavit that the matter has been settled between her and her husband. Both the wife and husband, i.e. respondent No.2 and petitioner No.1 respectively are present and stated that they are living together. Respondent No.2 has submitted that she does not want to pursue criminal case against the petitioners anymore.

Counsel for the parties have stated at the bar that the matter has been compromised. The matter involved is personal in nature.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the abovesaid FIR and the proceedings connected therewith are hereby quashed.
