1. The petition is filed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.573, dated 07.07.2014, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Jind.
2. The petitioner says that he has been in confinement from 27.07.2014. The trial has already commenced and the complainant himself has given evidence that he did not know about the facts of the case. Evidently, the complainant is not interested in prosecuting the case and the petitioner says that he has entered into compromise with the complainant.
3. The State on notice submits that the petitioner is guilty of similar such acts and two other cases are pending against him.

4. Having regard to the fact that the petitioner has been in confinement from 27.07.2014 itself and the trial has begun and the complainant not even supporting the prosecution, I do not think it is necessary to retain the petitioner in prison any longer. He shall be entitled to regular bail and he shall be released on furnishing surety bonds along with two sureties to the satisfaction of the trial magistrate. This order shall only address his rights in the present case.

5. The petition is allowed on the above terms.
