JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.212 dated 01.06.2014, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 324, 326, 506 of IPC, registered with Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

The genesis of the dispute between the parties, who are practising Lawyers at Pehowa, is to claim for allotment of Lawyers' Chambers.

The complainant-Advocate is stated to have received injuries at the hands of the present petitioner/Advocate-Ravinder Kajal. Three out of four other accused were granted anticipatory bail whereas one was granted regular bail by the learned trial Court.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 17.02.2015.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, states that the case is at the stage of framing of charge.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner/accused-Ravinder Kajal and the fact that the investigations are over, this Court finds that he deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Kurukshetra.
