Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Dr. Mohar Singh in case FIR No.21 dated 01.04.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 406 and 506 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga.

From the bare reading of the contents of the FIR, it is apparent that the dispute is purely civil in nature and colour of criminal offence is sought to be given.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from Inspector Gopal

Krishan states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no

longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 03.06.2015 is made absolute.
