RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioner seeks interim bail during pendency of anticipatory petition filed before the Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala.

Apparently petition for grant of anticipatory bail was filed before Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala on 27.05.2015 and notice was issued for 29.05.2015. Perusal of order dated 29.05.2015 shows that learned counsel on behalf of complainant appeared and even Police report was also filed by the State. The case is now adjourned for 04.07.2015 for arguments.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajesh K. Sheoran, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Keeping in view the nature of prayer involved in the petition, Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala before whom the anticipatory bail is pending is directed to decide the main petition forthwith by preponing the date of hearing on 08.06.2015.

Learned Magistrate, however shall inform the complainant as well as State before passing such order on merits. In case the Court feels that decision on merits of the case would take some time, then prayer for interim relief shall be considered by the Court on the said date.

If Court of concerned Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala is found to be non-operational due to vacations, then the District & Sessions Judge, would be obliged to assign this case to any other Court of competent jurisdiction.

A copy of this order be given to the learned counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of Bench Secretary of this Court.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
