This petition has been moved by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 452 dated 17.07.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 409 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code of Police Station City Fatehabad.

All the co-accused except the petitioner are on bail which fact is affirmed by the State counsel.

The petitioner is in custody since 04.01.2015 as was also mentioned in the last order.

Charge-sheet stands filed, but the charges have not been drawn up. The trial has, therefore, practically not begun.

All the offences, for which the petitioner is hauled up are triable by the Magistrate. He is neither a previous convict, nor wanted in any other case.

In view of the above, the request of the petitioner for bail is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
