Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.45 dated 27.04.2015, registered at Police Station Balongi, Mohali, under Sections 363 and 366-A of the Indian Penal Code, on the basis of compromise dated 15.05.2015 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has married Kritika, daughter of complainant and matter has been compromised. The petitioner has been behind bars since 28.04.2015.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from SI Ajaib

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Singh submits that Kritika, daughter of complainant, has married the petitioner and is residing with the petitioner. Statement of complainant has been recorded to this effect.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, SAS, Nagar, Mohali.
