Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 10, dated 12.03.2015, under Sections 498A, 494, 406, 420, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Women Police Station, Bathinda.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 05.06.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

Learned State counsel after receiving instructions from ASI Bikkar Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 05.06.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
