Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Daniel Masih, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 506 read with Section 148, IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No.128, dated 05.05.2015, registered at Police Station, Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Panna Lal of Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran, very fairly submits that the petitioner has been attributed the simple injury and in compliance of the order, dated 04.06.2015, he has joined the investigation and no more required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, interim direction issued by this Court vide order dated 04.06.2015 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.
